By The Numbers

- + \$151,972 spent in building facades
- + \$1,148,147 spent in other building repairs
- + \$941,350 was the combined cost of properties that sold
- + \$20,122.20 was spent on completed public projects-banners, signage, street signs, and trees
- + 9 new businesses opened creating 20 new jobs
- + 4 existing businesses moved into DT
- + 5 businesses had employee and/or space expansions
- + Downtown had a net gain of 40 new jobs and 7 businesses
- + 1046 volunteer hours were invested in Main Street Paragould, at a value of \$21,182
- + \$4850.40 was awarded to MSP from the Greene County Community Fund for improvements in Centennial Park
- + 12 e-newsletters were published
